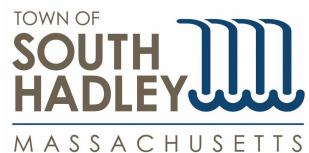




AUTUMN BIKE RIDE ROUTE MAP

Starts and ends at Rocky's Ace Hardware parking lot, 487 Newton Street (Route 116).

The ride is five miles long with approximately 200 feet of climbing (mostly at the beginning) and sticks to low-traffic roads or bike lanes/paths. We'll start from the parking lot at Rocky's by going north on Newton Street/Rt 116, and taking a right onto Mosier Street. After passing the schools, we'll take a right onto Westbrook Road. We'll then take a right onto Red Bridge Lane, and take the short car-free connection to Mountain View Street. We will follow Mountain View out to Route 202, and take a right onto the Route 202 bike lane. We'll take our next right onto Easy Street, and a left onto Margaret Street. We will then take a right onto Sunset Avenue, (using caution because of a low visibility corner). Continuing on Sunset as it becomes Dale and then Lloyd Streets, we will turn left onto Richview. Richview becomes Pittroff Avenue, passing some great views of Mount Tom over the cemetery. We will turn right to stay on Pittroff and then turn right onto the Lyman St Bike Path, and end by turning right back into the Rocky's parking lot.
